

Our Mission


To improve the quality of life for seniors-in-need through reliable and compassionate care.



ST. ANDREW'S MISSION MOMENT

Shelby an 85-year-old widow living in the city of St. Louis was on our Safe Home for Seniors program wait list for a handrail.

Shelby lives on a fixed income of \$1,600 per month and has several medical conditions including heart disease, asthma, and diabetes. When we were able to serve her, we learned during the assessment that her basement had flooded due to recent flash flooding and the water reached three feet high. Another agency was able to remove the damaged items from her home but did not have the resources to assist her with the deep cleaning and sanitization that she needed to make her home safe especially given her health conditions. St. Andrew's was able to locate a company to assess the situation and start the clean-up process within the same week. Shelby had no idea that when she initially contacted us for a handrail that we would be able to also help her with this matter. She stated it was a tremendous relief that St. Andrew's Safe Home for Seniors program was there to help during a crisis when she had no one else to turn to. 


